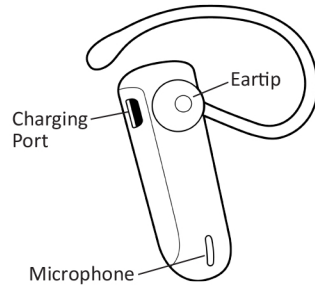
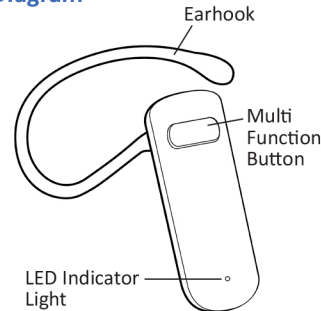

Instructions

Please charge the PNG260 for at least 2 hours before use. The red LED indicator means your headset is charging, LED will turn solid blue when battery is fully charged.

Pairing Your Device

Ensure that your phone's bluetooth is turned on.

1. With the PNG260 off, press and hold the silver button until the LED flashes red and blue.
2. Go to the settings on your phone and search for Bluetooth devices.
3. When your phone finds the headset, confirm by selecting the headset from the list.
4. If required, enter the pass code 0000 when prompted by your phone.
5. Repeat above steps if pairing was unsuccessful.
6. If pairing was successful, the indicator light starts to flash blue and you will not need to do this again.

General Operation

1. To turn on the headset, press the button until the blue light comes on.
2. To answer a call, press the answer key on your phone or press the silver button on the PNG260.
3. To redial the last number called, double tap button.
4. To activate Voice Dialling (your phone must support this function) press the button key once when PNG260 is in standby mode.
5. Use phone volume buttons to increase or decrease volume.

6. To turn on, press the silver button until the red light flashes .
